

# **2009 YELLOWSTONE RIFLE CLUB APPROVED HIGH POWER MATCHES**

SPONSORED BY:

**THE YELLOWSTONE RIFLE CLUB**

**DATES:** May 3rd, June 7th, and August 2nd, 2009 . Registration starts at about 7:00 AM in the YRC clubhouse; firing starts at about 8:00 AM. Vintage Military rifle matches will be held on June 6<sup>th</sup>, and August 1<sup>st</sup>. Three unapproved Mid-Range Prone matches (600 yards) will be held May 2nd.

**LOCATION:** Yellowstone Rifle Club Range is located at 7212 Molt Road about 2 miles west of Billings, Montana. (See map to the range on the Yellowstone Rifle Club website [www.yrc.org](http://www.yrc.org).)

**RULES and CLASSIFICATION:** Current NRA High Power rules will govern these matches. For Match and Service Rifle Competitors the NRA Classification system will be used. *An assigned classification may be used in lieu of a NRA High Power Classification.* A special **Scope-Match** will be held for competitors who wish to use any-sight (scope or electronic sights) rifles. All NRA rules governing equipment (other than sights), firing positions, alibis, scoring, safety, etc will be the same as non-Scope competitors. Scores for **Scope-Match** competitors will not be reported to the NRA. There will be no classification breakdown for **Scope-Match** Competitors at this time.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to men and women who support the rights of citizens to keep and bear arms. NRA, Montana Rifle and Pistol Assn (MRPA), memberships are encouraged. Membership forms will be available at registration.

On the day of the match post entries will be received in the club house on the range. Advance entries not confirmed and paid by 8:15AM will be forfeit. Post entries will be accepted up to the capacity of the range which is 36 shooters.

<i>Sub Juniors are 14yrs or less, Intermediate Juniors are 15 to 18 yrs, Seniors are 60 to 69 yrs and Grand Seniors are 70 yrs or older on the day of the match</i>

\*\* A Sub Junior, Intermediate Junior, Senior or Grand Senior Entry entitles these competitors to compete in all Indiv. Matches and the Aggregate and to win awards in all matches. If 3 or more Sub Juniors and/or Intermediate Juniors compete a Special Award to the High Sub or Intermediate Junior will be given.

**EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATORS:** Use of an "Empty Chamber Indicator" is required in all NRA Approved and Registered matches. Empty Chamber Indicators will be available at registration for \$1.50

**SQUADDING AND SCORING:** Competitors will be squadded for firing and pit duty. Paid pit service maybe available or the shooter may supply his own Pit person (someone qualified to do the job).

**CHALLENGES:** A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge lost.

**TARGETS:** Military type for Rifle Competition: 200yd - SR, 300yd - SR-3, & 600yd - MR-1.

**WEAPON:** NRA Match Rifle or Service Rifle; rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3, 3.1.4, 3.3. **Sights** – Metallic.  
**Scope-Match** Competitors use weapons as above and any-sights (scope or electronic).

**SCHEDULE:**

**Match 1** -- Indiv. match, Standing Slow Fire, 2 sighters and 20 shots for record, time -- 22 min., 200 yds. (**Competitors will remain on the line to fire Match 2**)

**\*Match 2** -- Indiv. match, Sitting or Kneeling from Standing, Rapid Fire, 2 sighters and 20 shots for record, time -- 60 sec per 10 shot string, 200 yds

*\*Grand Seniors may start in the sitting position but must wait to fire until the first shot is fired.*

**\*Match 3** -- Indiv. match, Prone from Standing, Rapid Fire, 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, time -- 70 sec per 10 shot string, 300 yds.

*\*Grand Seniors may start in the prone position but must wait to fire until the first shot is fired.*

**Match 4** -- Indiv. match, Prone Slow Fire, 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record, time --22 min., 600 yds.

**Match 5** -- Aggregate match, an aggregate of scores from matches 1 through 4.

**AWARDS:** Winners will have their choice of NRA award points or cash equivalent.

Award Schedule:

800 Agg -- Match and Service Rifle, awards by class. Winner has highest score in the match -- not the class.

**In the normal 800 agg match:** Classes may be combined if fewer than 3 individuals are registered in a class. Individuals will be notified prior to the beginning of the tournament if classes are to be combined. Masters will not be combined with the High Master Class. If fewer than 3 High Masters are entered they will compete for Match Winner Awards only. There will not be separate Service and Match rifle categories. **Scope-Match** awards will be separate and not be combined with Match and Service Rifle Competitors. No classes will be set up within the Scope Match this year.

**NOTES:** No lunch service is available at the range. Competitors may camp at the range while attending these matches. The YRC club house is available to roll out your bed roll – no charge. Water and sanitary facilities are available. There are 4 trailer hook-ups available (electricity only, \$10), there are other areas for camper units that are self-contained. Contact Steve Albright to reserve a RV location. A combination lock will be placed on the gate Friday afternoon so that competitors may have access to the range. The combination is 4-5-6-7.
