The 2010 National Indoor Championship is determined by scores fired in the local Sectional Tournaments, which are compiled at NRA Headquarters.

TIME OF FIRING: First relay will start at 9:00 AM and the second relay will start at 1:00 PM.

ELIGIBILITY: Senior competitors must be members of the NRA. Junior competitors must be members of the NRA or a NRA Affiliated Club. This is an YRC and not a NRA requirement. The YRC supports NRA membership.

TEAMS: A team will consist of four (4) firing members representing an NRA affiliated club (Rule 2.11 or (A), (B), a law enforcement agency (Rule 2.14), a regular service, National Guard or Reserve Unit (Rule 2.13

RULES: Current NRA Pistol Rules will govern.

TARGETS: B-2, slow fire target; B-3, timed and rapid fire target.

SCORING: Scoring will be done by Statistical Office Personnel. The use of a plug type scoring gauge is restricted to Match Officials and Statistical Office Personnel.

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. Challenge time will end one hour after scores are posted on the bulletin board.

ENTRIES: Entries are limited to 24 competitors – 12 each relay. Advance registrations are recommended. Post entries will be accepted up to the range capacity.

SQUADDING: All Matches will be squadded and fired in the order given in the match schedule. Each relay will complete firing before leaving the firing line. Team matches will be fired immediately after the individual firing for each relay.

FEES: NRA Sectional Registration Fees include entry in the 2010 NRA Indoor Pistol Championships.

NRA Individual Registration Fee: \$8.00 per competitor per match. NRA Team Registration Fee: \$8.00 per team.

Individual Matches (1-5): \$3.00 per match. Team Match: \$4.00 per team

MATCH SCHEDULE: All firing will be at 50 feet on NRA B-2 and B-3 targets.

The 2010 National Indoor Championship is determined by scores fired in the local Sectional Tournaments, which are compiled at NRA Headquarters.

TIME OF FIRING: Air Pistol competition will commence at approximately 11:00 AM and 3:00 PM

RULES: Current NRA International Pistol Rules will govern. Pistol will conform to NRA Rule 3.7

SCORING: Scoring will be done by Statistical Office Personnel. The use of a plug type scoring gauge is restricted to Match Officials and Statistical Office Personnel.

TARGETS: NRA Official 10 meter, B40/4 international air pistol target.

ELIGIBILITY: Senior competitors must be members of the NRA. Junior competitors must be members of the NRA or a NRA Affiliated Club. This is an YRC and not a NRA requirement. The YRC supports NRA membership. All teams will consist of **three (3)** firing members representing a club affiliated with NRA (Rule 2.11).

CATEGORIES: A woman and junior special award will be presented to the High Woman and High Junior in the National Individual Championship only.

CLASSIFICATION: Each competitor will be classified according to the NRA International Classification System in individual and team matches.

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. (See Rule 16.1 for correct procedure).

INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Entries are limited to 24 competitors – 12 each day. Advance registrations are recommended. Post entries will be accepted up to the range capacity provided such entries will not require extra relays.

TEAM ENTRIES: Team entries must be designated before the individual matches commence. The individual match scores will be used for the team score total. The team match is not a fired match.

FEES:

NRA Individual Sectional Registration Fee: \$8.00 per competitor includes entry of the individual in the 2010 NRA National Open Individual Indoor International Air Pistol Championships.

NRA Team Sectional Registration Fee: \$8.00 per team - includes entry of each team in the 2010 NRA Open Indoor International Air Pistol Team Championships.

Sectional Match Entry Fees: \$6.00 per individual.

Sectional Team Entry Fees: \$6.00 per team.

MATCH SCHEDULE:

MATCH #1 **Sectional Air Pistol Individual Championship.** Sixty (60) shots standing.* 10 Meters, Time limit, 105 min. (1 Hr., 45 Min.) Unlimited sighters are included within this time.

*NOTE: The 40 shot course for women and junior women will be authorized for sectional award. Those entering this course of fire will have their score cards annotated to reflect this course of fire. Separate awards will be provided. Competitors will only be eligible for awards in the categories entered.

AWARDS: Provided by the NRA:

Per NRA Award Schedule posted on the bulletin board.

Provided by the Yellowstone Rifle Club:

Classes will not be combined. Any individual earning a NRA provided award will not be eligible for a YRC award. Such awards will be passed down to the next eligible individual. Awards will be made for 1st in class, 2nd in class if 3 or more entries, 3rd in class if there are more than 5 entries.
